



How we got here:

- Engineered, nature-based and hybrid solutions are vital
- Scalability is enhanced by market and policy accelerants
- Robust measuring, monitoring and verification (MMV) plans are key to unlocking climate/carbon financing

Measuring, monitoring and verification (MMV)

Complex, but necessary:

- Growing recognition in the significance of MMV's role in shaping the carbon market
- Complexities and barriers surrounding MMV:
 - Measurement accuracy
 - Data availability and quality
 - Additionality/Permanence
 - Cost and resource considerations

- Leader in advancing carbon management solutions
- Establishing MMV pathways and innovations
- Comprehensive understanding of climate impact of emission removal, reduction and avoidance.






MMV for Carbon Management

Bias for Action

- Ideation Gathering intelligence to identify gaps in tech and urgent problems
- Generation Analyze requirements and translate to action
- Activation Mobilize network, fund solutions
- Opportunity: \$3 million total in funding available





Project Proposal Q&A

What makes a good project?

- Scalable innovation that is replicable to create greatest impact to enable global decarbonization
- Advancing solutions with a Technology Readiness
 Level (TRL) of 4-9
- Environmental, social, governance (ESG) and economic impact



Project Proposal Q&A

What types of solutions are eligible?

- Commercially viable pathways that enhance MMV of engineered, natured-based or hybrid carbon management pathways, such as:
 - Mineralization/geological sequestration
 - Ocean carbon removal (e.g. OAE)
 - Coastal carbon management (blue carbon)
 - Forestry management solutions
 - Soil carbon removal
- Proposals that include data management platforms that optimize the commercialization of carbon management solutions





Project Proposal Q&A

How are you evaluating the strength of MMV solutions to fund?

- We are evaluating applicants based on their potential impact to enable and scale carbon management solutions.
- As part of CICE's due diligence, we have partnered with a GHG verification team to support potential impact and scale of proposed solutions.

What is the maximum amount of funding per project?

 There is no limitation on the amount of funding requested, however smaller requests will be prioritized to accommodate multiple solutions.

 CICE intends to fund several projects of different sizes for a total up to \$3M



When can the funding be used?

- Contribution agreements for awarded projects will be put in place by October 6th, 2023
- Projects must start within 6 months of signing a contribution agreement
- The funding schedule will be specific to the project and aligned with the project spending and completion of pre-determined milestones



How can the funding be used?

- Salaries, consultants & project management
- Demonstration: Sites, operating costs, pilot production
- Prototypes
- Integrating system components
- Scaling up manufacturing




What is outside the funding scope?

- Day-to-day business operations
- Unrelated purchase capital equipment/leasehold improvements
- Furniture/equipment for routine business
- Advertising/forms of business promotion
- Human resource overhead

 Projects with strong co-funding and commercial support will be prioritized
